



CITY LOCAL WATERFRONT REVITALIZATION PLAN UPDATE  
Second Public Meeting

The City of Tonawanda will be holding the second public meeting for the update to the 1991 Local Waterfront Revitalization Plan (LWRP) and invites city residents, business-owners, and other interested individuals to hear about the progress, see some ideas, and share their input. This public meeting will be held on **April 12<sup>th</sup>, 2016 from 6:00 to 8:00 pm at City Hall.**

The LWRP, or waterfront plan, is a community-driven document that provides guidance on future policies, projects, and actions specifically related to the waterfront. The original plan was developed in 1986 and updated in 1991 and the City desires to take a proactive approach by developing a solid plan for the future of the waterfront, which includes the Niagara River, Two Mile Creek, Erie Canal, and Ellicott Creek. Funding for the update to the plan was provided by a grant from the New York State Department of State under the Environmental Protection Fund.
