

WE CANNOT ALLOW:

Erection of tents and canopies
Use of generators
Animal rides
Utilization of caterers without prior approval
Inflatable jump houses or similar equipment

Dogs

Glass containers

Not-for-profit/charitable organizations may not conduct fundraising activities without prior application and approval from the City of Tonawanda Common Council.

ADDITIONAL PARK RULES:

Please be advised that there is **NO parking on the grass**. A vehicle may **not** enter the park without attendant permission. Permission will only be granted (weather permitting) for the purpose of loading or unloading and then the vehicle must immediately leave the shelter area.

The use of staples on the shelters or picnic tables is prohibited. Tape is allowed or see the park attendant about tablecloth holders.

All garbage must be put in the provided totes with lids securely closed.
Totes are limited and extra trash may have to be taken with you.

Steel horseshoes can **only** be used in the horseshoe pits by the Veterans Park office. Rubber horseshoes may be used at other shelters.

The sand volleyball court and shuffleboard area are for use by **all** shelters.

Adjacent baseball/softball fields cannot be used without a permit.

The shelter has 13' x 3' charcoal grills for permit holder's use. Additional grills or fire pits may not be brought to the park or used.

Picnic tables may not be moved from the shelters.

Bands or sound systems must be in compliance with the City's sound ordinance and may not disrupt other shelter parties.

Kayak Boat Launch
Lavatory facilities
Horseshoe Pits
Volleyball net

Horseshoes and volleyballs may be borrowed from the park attendant

A bit of privacy - only one permit per day

Parking is limited. We highly recommend car-pooling
Children must be supervised

Eastern Park is more suited to private parties such as
wedding receptions or corporate/company picnics.

We ask that you respect the park.

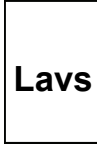

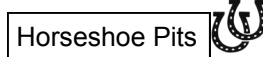

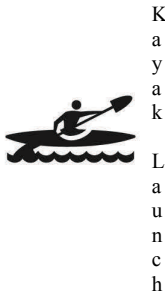
