

WE CANNOT ALLOW:

Erection of tents and canopies
Use of generators

Not-for-profit/charitable organizations may not conduct fundraising activities without prior application and approval from the City of Tonawanda Common Council.

ADDITIONAL PARK RULES:

Please be advised that there is **NO parking on the grass**. A vehicle may **not** enter the park without attendant permission. Permission will only be granted (weather permitting) for the purpose of loading or unloading and then the vehicle must immediately leave the shelter area.

The use of staples on the shelters or picnic tables is prohibited. Tape is allowed or see the park attendant about tablecloth holders.

All garbage must be put in the provided totes with lids securely closed. Totes are limited and extra trash may have to be taken with you.

Steel horseshoes can **only** be used in the horseshoe pits by the Veterans Park office. Rubber horseshoes may be used at other shelters.

The sand volleyball court and shuffleboard area are for use by **all** shelters.

Adjacent baseball/softball fields cannot be used without a permit.

All shelters have charcoal grills for permit holder's use. Additional grills or fire pits may not be brought to the park or used.

Picnic tables may not be moved from the shelters.

Bands or sound systems must be in compliance with the City's sound ordinance and may not disrupt other shelter parties.

Horseshoes, volleyballs, golf discs and shuffleboard equipment can be signed out from the park's office

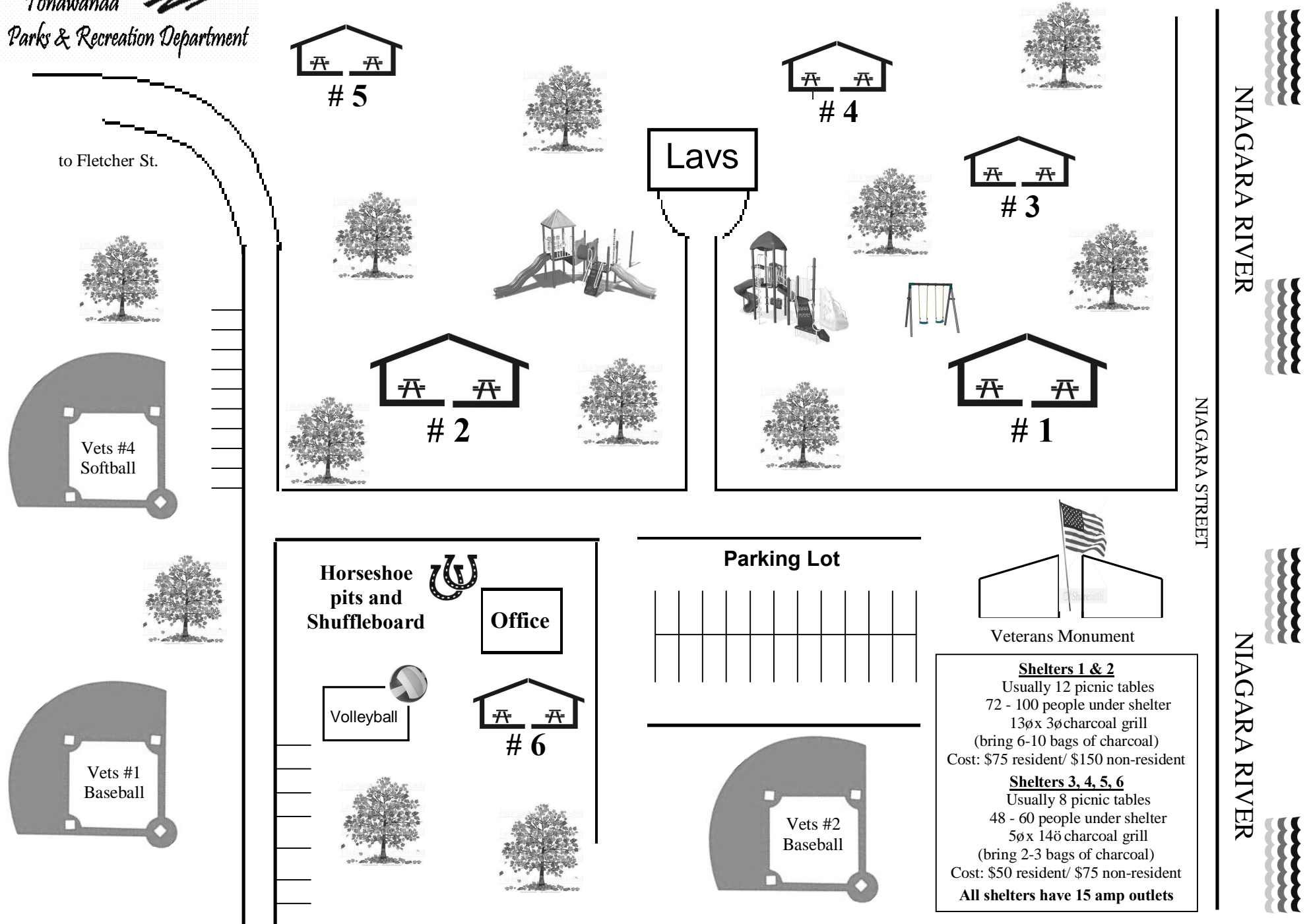
Parking is limited. We highly recommend car-pooling.

Shelters 1 & 2
 Usually 12 picnic tables
 72 - 100 people under shelter
 13ø x 3ø charcoal grill
 (bring 6-10 bags of charcoal)
 Cost: \$75 resident/ \$150 non-resident

Shelters 3, 4, 5, 6
 Usually 8 picnic tables
 48 - 60 people under shelter
 5ø x 14ø charcoal grill
 (bring 2-3 bags of charcoal)
 Cost: \$50 resident/ \$75 non-resident

All shelters have 15 amp outlets
